

# Our School Day

The children are expected to arrive at school between 8.45am and 8.55am.

The school day begins at 8.55am, when registration takes place.

The morning session runs from 8.55am to 12.10pm with a 20 minute break, 15 minutes of which is spent outside.

Lunchtime is 1 hour and 5 minutes, from 12.10pm to 1.15pm.

Children can have hot lunches cooked at the junior school on site or bring sandwiches.

The afternoon session runs from 1.15pm to 3.15pm.

Parents are expected to deliver children to the appropriate or most convenient door in the mornings and collect them at the end of the day from a named door.

The school provides child care until 6.00pm for working parents. (Beehive Club). The cost is £7.50 per session each day. The charge includes a snack, which is not intended as a meal replacement.

(A Breakfast Club is run by Purbrook Junior, which is also attended by children from our school, when places are available).

The school provides a wide range of enrichment opportunities beyond the curriculum through clubs. These take place for groups of children at lunchtime and after school. Currently these include: dance, football, multiskills, sports legacy club, choir, recorders, ocarina, ukulele, art, French, Go Club and computer club.
