Reminder: Book Week – 26 February to 2 March 2018

Our theme for Book Week this year will be "Let's Share A Story". Each year group will have a focus author for the week – Year R – Eric Carle, Year 1 – Julia Donaldson and Year 2 – James Mayhew. During the week the children will be sharing stories by their focus author as well as looking at books with moving parts for example pop-up books, lift the flap books and books with sliding pictures.

Each child will receive a £1 book token which can be exchanged for a Free World Book Day book or used to get £1 off any book worth £2.99 or more at participating bookshops.

Year One Trip: Wednesday 28 February

We still have a few children whose parents have not yet returned their consent forms together with a voluntary contribution. Please can you do this on **Monday**. Without your written consent your child **will not** be able to go on the trip and will have to remain in school.

Please can you ensure that your child arrives for school by 8.50am so that we are able to discuss with them the importance of listening to instructions; staying with their adult, and also have time to remind them of our expectations regarding behaviour. We will return to school in time for **normal collection at 3.15pm**.

The children must wear sensible footwear such as wellington boots or strong outdoor shoes with a good grip for this visit. We also ask that children wear trousers (jeans or joggers are permitted) and their school shirts/sweatshirts. We will be spending most of the day outside so please can you ensure that your child has warm clothing, hat, scarf, gloves and a warm, waterproof coat.

Reminder: World Book Day: Thursday 01 March

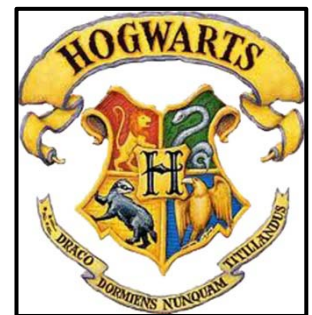
We are inviting the children to come to school dressed up as their favourite book character.
