Here at Purbrook Infant School we have developed a Forest School to give children the unique opportunity of experiencing first hand learning and play in a controlled outdoor environment. Led by our own trained Forest School Leaders, this experience will support the curriculum and have a strong emphasis on raising children's self-esteem and independence. An integral part of the Forest School experience is that children experience the outdoors in all weathers so unless weather is extreme, sessions will take place, even if for a shortened period.

Please check the weather forecast the day before and on the day of your child's session. However, as the weather is now cold, wet and highly changeable, to enable your child to access all activities please ensure you equip your child with the following:

- A waterproof coat with a hood
- Waterproof trousers
- An extra jumper or fleece
- Wellington boots or walking boots
- Hat, scarf and gloves (in colder weather)
- Sunhat, and tops with long sleeves (in warm weather)

As the area can become muddy, please ensure your child brings old clothes or clothes which are easy to wash.
