

The trust was established in 2004 and set up in memory of Tom Prince and is run in conjunction with Portsmouth Football Club and The News. The aim of the trust is to raise funds for research into the teenage bone cancer Osteosarcoma. This family run charity has received great support from friends and the local community and is a charity we have regularly supported.

To show our continued support this year, we would like all the children to come into school on Friday wearing something blue – this could be their Portsmouth Football Kit or other blue clothes. If they are also able to bring a voluntary cash donation we will ensure that the money is sent to this local and worthwhile cause.

#### **Term Dates**

We have today sent out a list of provisional dates for your diary. We will try to keep to these dates but sometimes it is necessary to make changes due to circumstances that are beyond our control. Where a change has to be made, we will always try to give you as much notice as possible. These dates are intended to highlight forthcoming events and further information will be relayed nearer the time, if necessary.

#### PE Kits in school

If you have not yet returned your child's PE kit, please can you do so on Monday. Throughout the summer term, whenever the weather permits, many of your child's PE sessions may take place outside. It is therefore **essential** for all children to have a PE kit and plimsolls in school to change into for outdoor exercise sessions.

#### Sun hats and Sun Cream

With the arrival of the hot weather we are currently enjoying, if you have not already done so, please can you support us to protect your child from the sun by providing them with a sun hat to wear in school.

A high factor sun-cream should also be applied thickly before school. Children may bring sun-cream into school in their book-bags to apply before lunchtime play but must be able to do so independently. It may be useful to practise with your child over the weekend so they can apply sun-cream swiftly, when necessary.

# **Water Bottles**

We encourage all children to keep themselves hydrated throughout the day and this is especially vital with the expected warmer weather this term. Children are encouraged to rinse their own water bottle each day when re-filling. At the end of each week in Year R all water bottles are fully disinfected by staff but in Years 1 and 2 children are encouraged to take their water bottles home each week for you to wash at home. If you wish your child's water bottle to be washed on a daily basis at home, please ensure your child knows to bring their water bottle home more often.

## **Reporting Absence**

A reminder that as well as telephoning the school, you can also report your child's absence via a company called **Studybugs** which enables you to go online via a phone or computer to report your child's absence securely.
