#### The Journey So Far: Year R

- First steps into school
- Experience of the whole school day
- New relationships with many children in class and across the year
- New relationships with key adults
- Highly enabling Year R environment including extensive outdoor areas
- Predictable routine with balance of adult led and child initiated activities

# The Year 1 Experience

- New class comprising children across year group
- New relationships with key adults (teachers / LSAs)
  - All about me 1 page updates
- New Year One environment and classroom
- Timetable and routines of day and week which build on Year R experience and develop children's capacity to be an independent learner
- Increased awareness and experience of belonging to the wider school

### **Transition into Year 1**

- Preparation with familiar Year R adults as part of PSED curriculum
- Last Wednesday your child spent a whole day with their new class, in their new classroom, with their new teachers and adults.
- They visited for a further afternoon yesterday (9<sup>th</sup> July)
- A third session is planned for Thursday afternoon (12<sup>th</sup> July)

- After school collection
- Water bottles
- Starting to become more responsible for their belongings
- PE kits please still name everything!
