# Assessment

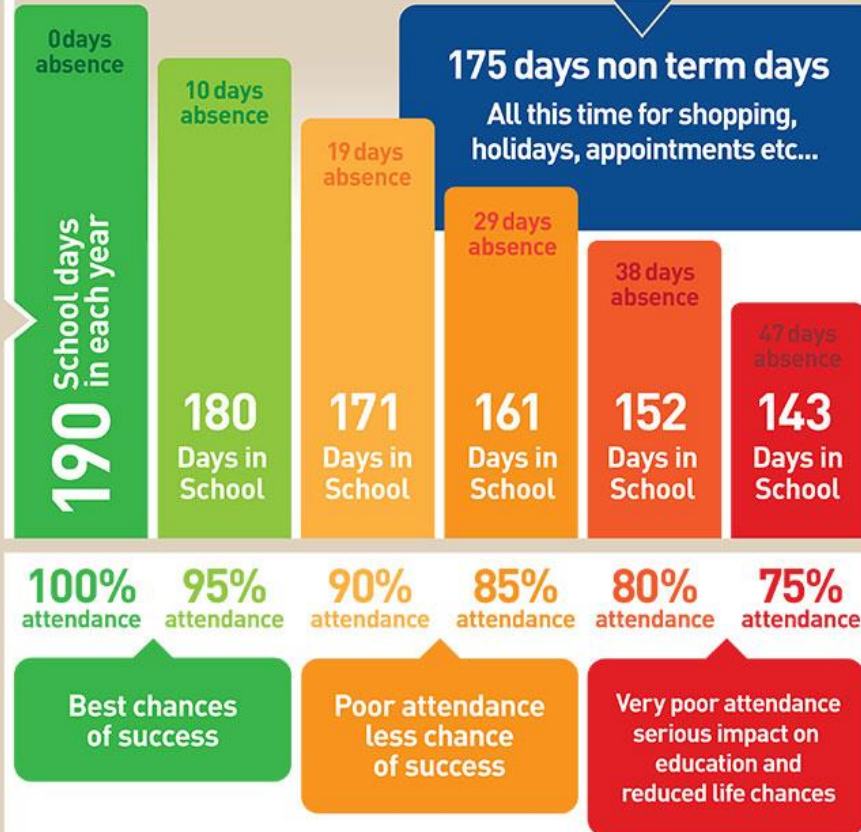
- End of Key Stage 1 Assessments (SATs)
