If you took your child's inhaler home at the end of the summer term, please can you ensure you provide a new one if your child still requires an inhaler. This should be taken to the school office. You may also wish to take the spacer home to clean it before returning it back to us.

Year 2 Music Tuition

Ocarina, recorder and ukulele lessons for all those who have signed up will commence next week. Lessons will take place on Monday lunchtimes for children learning the recorder, Tuesday lunchtimes for children learning the ukulele and on Friday lunchtimes for children learning the ocarina. Children need to ensure they have their instrument in school on the day that their lesson is taking place. If you have ordered an instrument for your child, we are hopeful these will be distributed at the first lesson.

In the early stages, children will be taken to their lessons. There will be ample time for the children to eat their lunch and spend some time on the playground with their friends as lessons have been carefully timetabled.
