Payee information is stated on the order form. Correct money only must be included as change will not be given. Please do not enclose any other monies owing to the school with your photograph order as we act as agents only, and do not open the envelopes.

The closing date for returning your order is **Tuesday 27 November.** Late orders will incur a charge by the photographic company. Please note that next year you will only be able to order copies online and not via the school.

Attendance

As we are starting to receive requests for absence I felt I should issue you with a reminder of the current situation.

Schools are expected to follow the Hampshire County Council Code of Conduct for legal intervention relating to term time absence and not to authorise pupil absence unless the reason for the absence is exceptional.

Under the Code of Conduct, a penalty notice should be issued to parents where a pupil has 10 unauthorised absence sessions in the last 100 school sessions and there are no exceptional reasons why the pupil has been prevented from attending school. Please note that one day is recorded as two sessions.

"Penalty Notice Warning in accordance with Hampshire County Council's Code of conduct: If a child has any unauthorised absence during any formal examinations, testing or assessment as publicised via our school website or parent/carer newsletters this will result in the issuing of a Penalty Notice for non-attendance." (*This includes Year 1 Phonics testing, Year 2 Phonics re-testing and Year 2 Teacher Assessments.)

The dates of these tests are detailed below

- Year 1 Phonics Testing and Year 2 Phonics re-testing June 2019
- Year 2 Teacher Assessments 1 May to 24 May 2019

Where a pupil has persistent lateness to school, and this is impeding pupil progress, parents should be clearly warned that, unless the pupil's punctuality improves, further lateness will be recorded as unauthorised absence. This unauthorised absence may lead to a penalty notice being issued when the 10 session threshold has been reached.

Parents are advised that if they receive a Penalty Notice there is **no right of appeal** unless it can be proved that it has been issued in error or unlawfully. The HCC Behaviour and Attendance webpages contain a statement explaining the legal position, please see link below.

Please note that a penalty notice may be issued to one or more parents/carers and is currently £60 per penalty notice if paid within the required 28 day timescale. If a penalty notice is not paid within the timescale it will increase to £120. If this is not paid in the required timescale, then legal action will be taken.

Reporting Absence

A reminder that as well as telephoning the school, you can also report your child's absence via a company called **Studybugs** which enables you to go online via a phone or computer to report your child's absence securely. To get the free Studybugs app, or register on their website go to (https://studybugs.com/about/parents). If your child is unwell it is your responsibility to inform the school of this.
