

Christmas Lunch: Tuesday 18 December

A reminder that on Tuesday the children will be served this celebratory lunch by the staff. The PTFA will provide all the children with crackers. The children will order their Christmas lunch in class, on Tuesday. The menu will be as follows:

Roast Turkey with sausage, stuffing ball and gravy or Quorn fillet with vegetarian sausage, stuffing ball and gravy. They will be served with roast potatoes, garden peas and carrots. The dessert will be chocolate ice cream or a satsuma. The PTFA will be providing all children with a Christmas cracker, regardless of whether they have a school lunch or not. No other lunch options will be available on this day.
