Year R Cake Sale: Thursday 04 April



We have our last cake sale planned for Thursday 04 April. So far we have beat the amount raised at each sale so let's see if we can make this sale the biggest yet! Any unsold cakes will be available for sale from the school office on Friday 05 April. We would be very grateful if you could follow the nation's enthusiasm and bake a cake for us to sell so we can raise money our new library. Or, if baking is not for you, that you donate some shop bought cakes for us to sell.



Please can we request **NO NUTS** of any kind are included in any of the items donated. If you donate a cake in a container that you would like returned to you, please can you ensure that it is marked clearly with your child's name and class so that we can ensure it makes its way back to you.

If you will be making a cake, please can we request that this is sliced into reasonable portion sizes at home. Please can you try to bring some loose change with you and not large notes, as the change we have will be limited. Cakes will be priced at either 30p or 50p.

Sandwich bags will be available for you to take your cakes home, however, you may prefer to bring in a plastic container so the cakes don't get squashed.

We would also be grateful for offers of help. Either to set up before the cake sale or to sell the cakes at the end of the day. Please leave your name at the office if you are able to help.

Reminder: Cake Raffle

One of our parents, Sam Page of Caylin's Cakes, who makes cakes professionally has very kindly offered to make a chocolate drizzle cake (see picture on left) for us to raffle. This cake retails at £55. Raffle tickets will be priced at £1 each and will be drawn on the day after the last cake sale - Friday 05 April. This winner of the cake can choose the date they would like their cake to be baked.

We have today sent out a slip with each child which will enable you to enter the raffle (if you wish). Tickets are £1 per entry. Additional tickets can be obtained from the school office. Alternatively, you can just write the details on a slip of paper.
