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### Coats in school

Please can you ensure that your child has a coat with them in school every day. The weather is very changeable at the moment and can suddenly turn cold. Many thanks.

### Water Bottles

We encourage all children to keep themselves hydrated throughout the day and this is especially vital with the expected warmer weather this term. Children are encouraged to rinse their own water bottle each day when re-filling. At the end of each week in Year R all water bottles are fully disinfected by staff but in Years 1 and 2 children are encouraged to take their water bottles home each week for you to wash at home. If you wish your child's water bottle to be washed on a daily basis at home, please ensure your child knows to bring their water bottle home more often.

### Parking on Zigzag Lines

We have been informed about an incident this week which took place on the zigzags by the School Crossing Patrol Officer on Woodlands grove/Elizabeth Road. Parents dropping their children off by stopping on zigzags have caused an accident. This has been reported to the police and council.
