

Hay fever and other allergies

If you notice that your child has a runny nose or itchy eyes, then please can you give them the appropriate medication **before** they come to school. There are medications available that can be given once a day or ones that can be given morning or evening. Please speak to your pharmacist or doctor to find out which one is the best for your child and we would be grateful for your support in this matter.
