Change of Lunch Option Next Tuesday 18 June

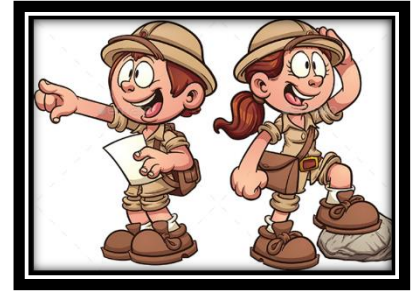
Due to a special event taking place in Year 1 next Tuesday we are offering all the children a special lunch. No other option will be available. The options available are:

School Uniform

As you are aware, we have changed from selling uniform on site to an external company, Skoolkit in Havant. However, we do still have some uniform in stock and these are available at a lower price:


