Assessment

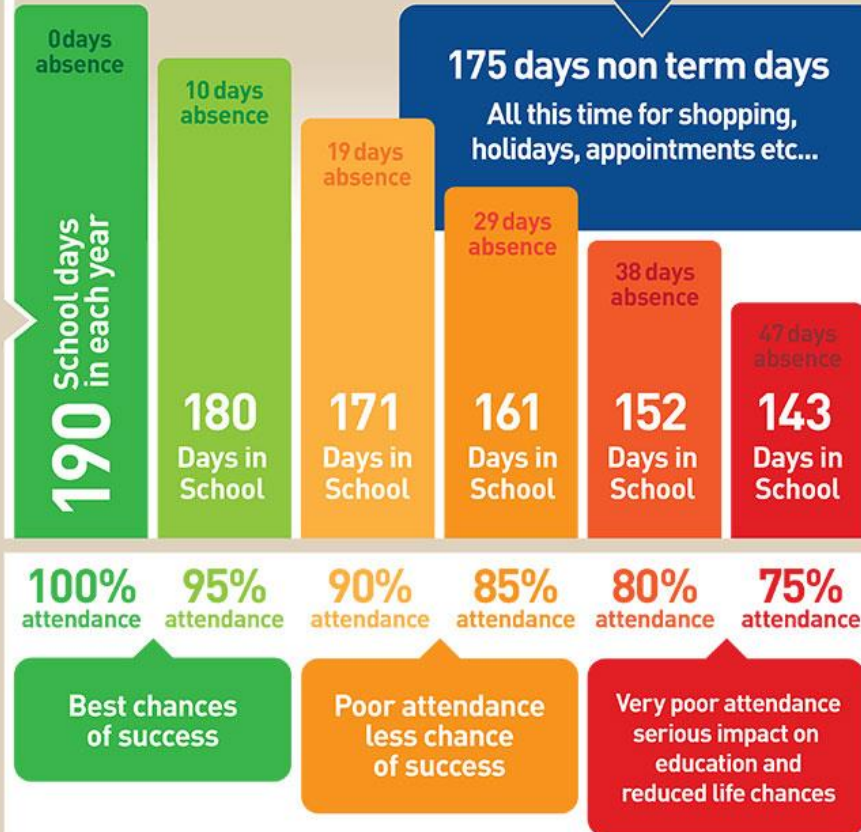
- Teacher assessment continues throughout Year 2
