

Purbrook Infant School PTFA Christmas Market



As you know Christmas is fast approaching and the PTFA are starting to organise their Christmas activities. One of the things that we do each year, is to put on a Christmas Market for all the children to enjoy.

If your child is in Years 1 or 2, then they will probably have taken part in these before. The market takes place over three mornings during school time. Your child is invited to come to the market and buy a Christmas gift for members of their family, Mum, Dad, siblings, Nanny, Grandad etc. The gifts are £1 each. The children have a personal shopper to help them choose their gifts and the gifts are wrapped and tagged ready to go under your Christmas tree. Each child can buy gifts for a maximum of six people. The PTFA need to buy all the presents in advance, potentially 6 for each of the pupils in school. That's around 1500 gifts!

Therefore, we ask that you **send the correct money with the form below**, indicating the people who your child would like to buy for, the name to go on the gift tag and age of any children, in an envelope marked Christmas Market. Please return the slip to school, via your child's class teacher as soon as possible, as buying such a large number of gifts takes some time to do. Your child can choose to buy gifts from the following groups - Mum/Nan, Dad/Grandad, teen boys, teen girls, boys 7-10, girls 7-10, boys 3-6, girls 3-6 and babies/tots.

The PTFA would very much appreciate your help in returning this reply slip and the appropriate monies before 25th October. Cheques are to be made payable to Purbrook Infant School PTFA.
