Forest School Helper

This term Mrs Rolfe has been luckily enough to have help during Forest School Sessions. We would like to share some information about her with you. Her name is Justyna Lewandowski and she is a qualified child worker from Germany. She has twelve years' experience working with children both in the UK and in Germany. She has worked in various nurseries in Germany, as well in a youth centre, with children aged 6-17. In Germany she took part in a month's work experience at a Forest kindergarten and organized a three-day forest adventure break for thirty-three children aged 8-12. In the UK she has worked in two different nurseries as a nursery practitioner and also as a nanny.

She has also recently completed her initial Forest School Leader Training (Level 3), with the Hampshire and Isle Wight Wildlife Trust. To help aide her training she decided to work voluntarily here at the school to gain experience in a Forest school setting.
