Environment Week Monday 10 February

Further to our recent letter, a reminder that this event is taking place next week. We hope that taking part in this week will help our children to learn about how we can reduce the amount of non-recyclable pollution which is endangering our wildlife and environment, and to be extra vigilant about littering and choosing to avoid single-use plastic wherever possible. We have asked that children who have a packed lunch at school come in with no single-use plastic packaging in their lunch box — so no disposable bottles, *crisp packets* etc (see below). Sandwiches and other lunch box contents could be wrapped in a beeswax wrap, tin foil or come in a container (plastic such as Tupperware is reusable and is acceptable!) and please make sure your child has a reusable water bottle with them.
