

Handwriting Challenge 3

Cut out the cards and place them face down. Take a card, turn it over and write the word in your best cursive handwriting. Repeat this four times.

Make up a silly sentence using the cards. You can use as many words as you want. Remember to use your neatest writing with clear ascenders (tall letters) and descenders (letters with tails under the lines)

<i>the</i>	<i>laid</i>	<i>five</i>	<i>large</i>
<i>speckled</i>	<i>boxes</i>	<i>jumped</i>	<i>over</i>
<i>chicken</i>	<i>purple</i>	<i>tiny</i>	<i>pink</i>
<i>egg</i>	<i>with</i>	<i>then</i>	<i>feathers</i>

You can repeat the above activity a few times, making different silly sentences each time.

Want a change? Swap some of the words for different ideas and make some more daft sentences!

Or you could choose a favourite part of a story or poem and write it out using your best handwriting, and decorate the page with patterns or drawings. Did you know that drawing is a good way to improve your handwriting because you are learning to control your pencil!
