'Dinosaurs' continues as the theme for our learning this half term. There is a design a dinosaur job (see below) that explores some more scientific and geographic aspects of dinosaurs. We will use these in our literacy work next week. There are new literacy and maths jobs too.

## Design a Dinosaur

### Step 1

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#### **Dinosaur Teeth**

Read the information book about teeth on the school website. Design some teeth for your dinosaur. What food will it eat? What shape will they be?

You could draw them or if you're feeling more adventurous make them using anything you have around the house!

## Step 2



#### Skeleton

Use the <u>Dippy the Dinosaur – Longest Bone</u> pack to find out about the longest bone in most mammals. Try to answer all the questions on p17 of the pack (you could copy the questions into your workbook). You might like to print off and tape together Dippy's thigh bone.

Now design the skeleton for your dinosaur. What shape bones will it have? Will it be tall, short, long, thin, fat...?

You could use pasta shapes or straws to create the skeleton. Or feel free to draw it. Can you label the femur (thigh bone) and its skull?

#### Habitat

## Step 3



A habitat is a place where an animal or in this case a dinosaur lives. Look at the different places that dinosaurs lived using the habitats photos on the school website.

Choose where your dinosaur would have lived and find out about these places today. For example, where are shorelines? Which country have deserts?

Draw a picture of your dinosaur's habitat. Can you describe what it is like there? Use these sentence starters to help you.

Step 4



You can use anything you like at home to create your dinosaur. You might decide to make a full-size painting, a model, a drawing, a collage...
