<p><u>Geography</u> Jet off to the second largest continent, Africa. There are 4 helpful videos which will tell you lots about this fascinating continent. Can you write 5 fun facts that you learnt?</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Read through 'African patterns' on the Year 1 page. Then make your own pattern inspired by your surroundings, using bold colours. You could use: Pencils, Paints, Felt tip pens, Chalk etc. Be creative!</p>
<p><u>Geography</u> Find out what daily life is like for a child living in urban (city) Kenya here. Find out what daily life is like for a child living in rural (country) Kenya here. What is the same and what is different? How do their days compare to yours?</p>	<p><u>Dance</u> Watch the video about African drumming and dance sequences.
