Writing tasks

Please watch the story <u>Katie Morag and the Tiresome Ted</u> by Mairi Hedderwick. This will help you to complete activities 1 & 2.

Activity 1: Retell the story Katie Morag and the Tiresome Ted.

Once you have watched the video retell the story to an adult in your home. There are visual aids to help you on the Year 1 page if you need them.

Activity 2: Draw characters and write captions

Watch the video to recap the story. Think about how the different characters may be feeling throughout the story. Draw a picture for 3 or 4 parts of the story and include a caption underneath to explain how the character is feeling or what they may be thinking. Below is an example of how you may choose to complete this activity.

Activity 3: Create a poster about Wales

Did you know that there are over 600 castles in Wales! Read some facts about Wales on the Year 1 page. Pick at least 3 of your favourite facts to create an informative poster about Wales. **Steps to success:**

It must be eye catching so use pictures and colours.

Remember to use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

You have the facts on the fact sheet so we will expect correct spellings to be used. Include a title

You may wish to also use subtitles such as <u>Did you know?</u> You separate your facts.

Activity 4: Learning the suffix 'er'

We use adjectives when we are describing nouns. When we are comparing we often need to add the suffix 'er' at the end of an adjective. Here are some examples:

- big → bigg<u>er</u>
- small → smaller
- brighter \rightarrow bright<u>er</u>

Here are some sentences using adjectives with the suffix er: The green dragon has a longer tail. The red dragon has sharper teeth.

Practise writing your own sentences. You can compare these dragons or find two items or pictures of your own to compare.
