Topic: Water

As this is the last week of school, we are winding down and have thought of a few fun activities to end the year with!

<u>Literacy</u>

- 1. Write down your favourite memory of Year R. It could be when Farmer Ian came to visit, the Christmas performance, a marble treat or something else!
- 2. Write a list of things that you are excited about for Year One. If you have any worries or questions, you could write these down too and email them in.

<u>Maths</u>

- 1. Play a number splat game. Write down the numbers from 10-20 and spread them out, then ask a grown-up to say a number and splat it as quickly as you can. You could do a small splat with little pieces of paper and splat them with your hand, or a giant splat outside and jump on them!
- 2. Sing your favourite maths song. This could be a maths nursery rhyme such as 5 little ducks, or one of the YouTube songs we have practiced over the year (Mr Double Trouble, 3D shapes etc).

Other

- 1. Record a message for your old or new teacher and send it into school for them to watch! You could even record a message for a friend who is in school at the moment too.
- 2. Create a countdown poster or calendar to count the days until you can come back to school.
- 3. Design the front cover of a Holiday Journal book. You could use this book to write, draw, photograph or scrapbook the exciting things that you do over the next six weeks and you could even bring it in to show your new teacher in September!
- 4. Think of a way to say thank you to the grown-up(s) who have been helping you with your learning at home. You could draw them a picture, help them with something tricky, bake a cake for them or even just say some kind words to them!
