

Doubling – Up to 20

Double 5 =	Double 2 =	Double 3 =	Double 10 =
Double 11 =	Double 12 =	Double 13 =	Double 14 =

Orange Work – Up to 50 (no bridging)

Double 22 =	Double 34 =	Double 41 =	Double 20 =
Double 24 =	Double 32 =	Double 42 =	Double 44 =
Double 23 =	Double 21 =	Double 31 =	Double 43 =

Green Work – Doubles that bridge

Double 27 =	Double 36 =	Double 47 =	Double 29 =
Double 26 =	Double 38 =	Double 45 =	Double 47 =
Double 28 =	Double 26 =	Double 39 =	Double 48 =

Note for parents:

Bridging is where the 'ones' being added together exceed ten.

Double 12 does not bridge the tens barrier, you can easily double ten and then double the 2.

Double 16 does bridge, as you would need to solve $10 + 10$ (20) and then $6 + 6$ (12) and then add 20 and 12.
