1. Take part in the Hampshire reading challenge or read at least 10 times.
2. Check that you can read and write most of the Year 2 common exception words.
3. Look at the Year 3 common exception words (start to learn to read and spell them)
4. Practise counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s (forwards and backwards).
5. Learn how to write numbers greater than 100 and know what they are made of.
(How many hundreds, how many tens and how many ones)
6. Go on a rock hunt, can you find some different types of rocks? Can you research them?
7. Practise a sport that you enjoy (there are lots of sports activities at the juniors)
8. Find a poem that you like (there are lots online).
9. Finally, learn the names of some bones that are found in our bodies.
10. Practise writing extended sentences.
(sentences which include and, or, but, because, when, before, after, while and so)
