We have now completed all of the Year 2 curriculum so this week's learning will be focussed on looking forward and back, with a few other tasks.

<p>Reading: Daily reading Well done to everyone who has kept up with their daily reading. Reading is so important in order to keep moving forward with your fluency and understanding.</p> <p>This week we would like you to choose the book that you have enjoyed the most at home and create a book review. Please email your book reviews in as we can put them in our book corner for next year's Year Two children. We have provided a template for you to use if you wish.</p>	<p>Writing: My time in Year Two Use the template provided to create a poster on your experience in Year 2. Think about what you have enjoyed, who you have made friends with and what your favourite topics/lessons have been. This is a nice time to look back and reflect on your final year in Purbrook Infant School.</p>	<p>Maths: Finding the difference grid Start on orange and colour in two numbers that have a difference of 10. You may want to work this out by starting on the lowest number and counting on 10 to find the number pair. Another way to do it is to start on the bigger number and then subtract 10 and see what number you land on. EXT: Once you've completed Orange and Green tasks you might want to have a go at writing in your own number pairs that have a difference of 7.</p>								
<p>PHSE: Moving on Last week you had the chance to have a final zoom meeting with your Year 2 teacher and find out who your teacher will be in Year 3. Now we would like you to think ahead to your time in Year 3 and think about what your targets are for next year. This could be social, educational or about your mind set (e.g. I want to try to be more confident, I want to make new friends, I want to learn to play an instrument). You will also need to think about yourself and your interests and strengths.
