We have set up a specific email address which should only be used for **positive cases of children attending this school**. This is: covidabsence@purbrook-inf.hants.sch.uk please do not use any other email addresses as these may not be monitored as regularly during the half term break. When sending the email please can you ensure that you include the following information:

- Your child's name
- Their class
- Their date of birth
- The date the test was taken
- A mobile telephone number in case we need to contact you


This information will enable us to work with Public Health Officers to ensure the relevant people are notified.
