1 December – 11 December	Christmas Cards: Each class will have a box/sack and the cards will be quarantined at the end of each week and then given out the following

10 December	Christmas Lunch: This year the school caterers will be providing the children with a Christmas Buffet Box. To make this extra special all the children will be decorating a place mat and the PTFA will be providing all the children with a Christmas Cracker and Christmas music will be playing to make it more festive
	The children can come to school dressed in a Christmas Jumper in exchange for a contribution of ± 1
Week Commencing 14 December	Christmas Items: All the children will be making something which you can purchase for £1. Please see pictures on next page. Children in Year R will be designing their own decorations so you may well get a pink reindeer or an orange Christmas Tree!
14 December	Santa Claus is coming to town: On this day Santa will be coming to school to read a story to all the children. He will of course be following social distancing guidelines as we don't want Santa to have to self-isolate over Christmas!

17 December	Year 1 Christmas Party: On this day the children can come to school dressed in party clothes. In return we are asking for a contribution of £3 which will go towards the cost of the food. All the children will also be bringing home a bag of chocolate coins for them to eat at home
18 December	Festive Mufty Day (last day of term): On this day the children can come to school wearing festive clothing in exchange for a voluntary contribution of £1
