Flu Vaccination

If you gave your permission and your child was in school on Wednesday 23 November, they would have received their vaccination. The unique code for our school is **SH115937** and you will need to add this code to the school field on the form. Once you have completed an E-consent form for your child please call 0300 0030323 to make an appointment at one of their community clinics.

Reporting Absence

A reminder that as well as telephoning the school, you can also report your child's absence via a company called **Studybugs** which enables you to go online via a phone or computer to report your child's absence securely. To get the free Studybugs app, or register on their website go to (<u>https://studybugs.com/about/parents</u>). If your child is unwell it is your responsibility to inform the school of this.

Covid Absence Reminder

If your child self isolates due to a close contact showing symptoms and they subsequently test positive for Covid-19, please can you inform the school as soon as possible. If a child test comes back as positive outside of normal school hours, we have a designated email inbox as we would like you to inform us so we can act on this information before school starts. This is: <u>covidabsence@purbrook-inf.hants.sch.uk</u>. It is really important that we are informed as soon as possible if a child were to test positive for Covid-19 as we need to take immediate action to stop the virus spreading.

If we have to close a bubble, we will ideally phone parents. Where this is not possible, due to the time of the day we are notified, an email will be sent out via ParentMail as this is a quicker way of contacting parents and would be helpful first thing in the morning so you do not get to school, only to be sent home again. If you have not already done so, why not download the free ParentMaill App so you can see notifications immediately.
