Year 1 Learning at Home Spring Term 1 2021: Walking with Dinosaurs

Welcome to our second full day of home learning. We will be starting each day with a zoom session to meet up with the children and preparing them for the activities to complete each day. Please try to attend one of the time slots - they are not linked to classes.

As you will be learning at home this half term, we have created a Year 1 YouTube Video which we will use to upload videos to teach new concepts and explain activities. Here is the outline for our day's learning. The times are a guide for how we organise the day at school. You will have complete flexibility to fit around your family with home working and sibling's demands for devices, etc. If you have any questions or queries, please email the year 1 team using <u>year1@purbrook-inf.hants.sch.uk</u>. We would like to see your learning - photographs work well - sent to this address too, so that teachers are able to respond to what you have done at home, make suggestions for improving work and monitor how children are finding the tasks.

<u>8.50 - 9.25 Science</u>

Watch the video about observable features on the YouTube channel.

If you have toy dinosaurs at home, you need them for this activity! Watch the video about observable features. Have a look at your dinosaur toys or the printable sheet of dinosaurs. How many different **observable features** can you spot? Choose one of the features, and create a group of dinosaurs that share that feature. For example, create a group of dinosaurs with horns or ones that have spines. Give your group a label to explain how you have grouped the dinosaurs.

9.25 - 9.40 Handwriting

Practice writing your full name (first name, middle names and surname) using a capital letter for the start of each word, and forming all letters correctly. Use lined paper and make sure that letters are positioned correctly (i.e. tail letters under the line y, g, p, tall letters such as k, t). Parents/carers: please watch carefully as bad habits are really hard to break!

<u>9.40 – 9.55 Snack Time</u>

<u>9.55 - 10.40 Maths</u>

Count forwards from 1 to 100. Join in with our video here.

Miss McKelvey is going to introduce today's maths lesson. The video is available on the YouTube channel. This session is practicing our addition and subtraction skills, writing number sentences to match pictures and writing inverse number sentences. e.g. 5 + 3 = 8 / 8 - 5 = 3

Watch the video and you may want to work through the examples on the pdf together, then there are some questions for your child to complete independently.

If you don't have a printer, write the questions onto paper.

There are three levels of questions. Complete at least 4 questions from page 2 and page 3. If you can do more that's great. There is a puzzle to solve on page 4 which is aimed at children who complete the first two pages confidently and with very few errors.

10.40 - 11.05 Shared Learning Time

Children plan their learning tasks using one of these areas:

- Small world (construction, dinosaurs, cars, trains, etc.)
- Creative (painting, collage, drawing using chalks, pastels or junk modelling)
- Reading
- Writing

Encourage your child to use different activities over the week.

11.05 - 11.35 Phonics

1.00 - 2.00 English

Look at the vocabulary you thought of to describe the dinosaur in first session or look at the picture of the dinosaur again and think of different ways to describe the dinosaur. Today we are going to write some sentences about the dinosaur.

Use the words you thought of to write sentences about the dinosaur. There is a dinosaur word mat to help you with spelling. It would also be a good idea to download our sound mats that we use in school. We understand that it is tricky to know how much support to give your child

with writing. They will not be able to spell many words correctly yet, but they are all very good at using their phonic knowledge now and should be expected to do this. If you are unsure how to help your child, pop onto zoom at 3.00 and one of the year 1 teachers will be happy to give you some support.

Finding it hard? If your child is finding it hard to think of a sentence, begin every sentence with 'The dinosaur has...' They can all spell /the/ correctly; the word dinosaur is on the word mat and they can sound out has.

Challenge: Make sure you use adjectives (describing words) in all your sentences. Add more detail to your sentence using the word 'and' or 'because' e.g. The dinosaur has sharp teeth because it eats meat.

Please listen to your child read their reading book daily if possible. If you need more books, read an e-book from here. You will need to register your email address to access them the first time you use them.
