Music – Pitch

https://classroom.thenational.academy/units/pitch-c0a5 Follow the sessions from the National Academy that focuses on pitch. The **pitch** of a sound is how **high** or **low** the sound is. A high sound has a **high pitch** and a low sound has a **low pitch**. A tight drum skin gives a higher pitched sound than a loose drum skin.
