


Joey on the move


Newborn joeys have strong arms, but their legs and tails have not yet grown.

As soon as the joey is born, it begins a difficult climb.

It grips its mother's fur and pulls itself up her body to her pouch. The mother does not help her joey.

⇒The arrows show the joey's journey. This is the path the mother licked across her belly.





Ready, steady, grow!

Inside the pouch, a joey feeds, sleeps and grows. It is a cosy place for a young animal.

The joey stays attached to its mother's nipple for about ten weeks. The joey changes slowly at first. It is nearly five months old before it can open its eyes.

Then the joey pushes its head out and looks around. It will soon be ready to leave the pouch.



☆ For the first few months, the joey slowly grows bigger.
