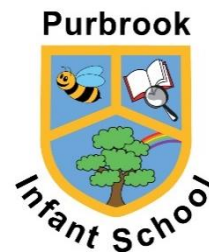

Dear Parents/Carers

### **Beehive After School Club**

I am writing to you as we are busy planning on reopening the Beehive Afterschool Club on Monday 08 March. It is with a sad heart that I must inform you that the club, like many other self-funded businesses, finds itself in a very precarious financial position. This club is totally reliant on the fees that we charge parents to pay staff salaries and all other related costs and receives no government funding.

Whilst we have been able to furlough staff, this only represents 80% of salaries and the club has had to finance the remainder 20% of salaries and on-costs. As year-end approaches, we will, unfortunately, be reporting to our governors, that the club is in the red to a significant amount.

I really want for this club to be able to remain open as I know how many parents value and need the service that it provides.
