Year 1 Space Day Tuesday 21 September 2021

We are really excited to be arranging a 'Space Day' for the Year 1 children on Tuesday 21 September 2021. It will be a whole day that will immerse the children in learning about space, building on aspects that they are keen to find out more about:

- What do we find in space?
- How do we get to space?

The children will have the opportunity to visit a mobile planetarium during the day which will enable us to experience the sights and sounds of space in a really exciting way. We are really keen to provide the children with experiences that enhance their learning such as the planetarium however, we are reliant on voluntary contributions from parents to cover the costs as the school budget does not enable us to offer these.
