<b>Key Vocabulary</b> - discuss and remember and embed.	Shape-Shape is everywhere! Everything is made out of shapes. When painting you can use knowledge of 2D shapes to help you with your drawings e.g. planets, when painted in 2D, are circular in shape  Straight lines/curved lines-paintings are made up of straight and curved lines. It is where you place these lines and the angles you put them that help you to create a picture  Colour mixing-paints are mixed together before applying to the paper to create a colour.  Colour blending-colours are blended on the paper to create effect or tone.  Tone-light/darkness of a colour
