#### Year 1 Autumn B: Stories around the World

Question to explore...	Do all stories start 'Once upon a time'? What's for Christmas Dinner?
Art Coverage	To create Christmas wrapping paper using printing techniques. Polystyrene tiles to be used.
<b>NC Coverage</b>	
To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To create a polystyrene printing tile so as to print Christmas wrapping paper. This can be a Christmas shape made of string and glued onto the tile or it could be a design cut into the tile.</li> </ul>
To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children will make a simple printing block from polystyrene printing tiles or similar. This will then be loaded with paint or ink and a regular pattern will be made using the tiles. This can be a Christmas shape made of string and glued onto the tile or it could be a design cut into the tile.</li> </ul>
To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children will make a simple printing block from polystyrene printing tiles or similar. This will then be loaded with paint or ink and a regular pattern will be made using the tiles. This can be a Christmas shape made of string and glued onto the tile or it could be a design cut into the tile.</li> </ul>
To learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.	
<b>Key Vocabulary</b> - discuss and remember and embed.	<p><b>Printing</b> is the process of making images that can be transferred onto other surfaces. It can be used to make one or more identical images or to create repeating patterns on papers and textiles.</p> <p><b>Block printing</b> (also called Relief printing) is the process of carving patterns, shapes and designs into a 'block'.</p> <p><b>Tile</b>- A piece of polystyrene which can be cut into or things stuck onto to create a printing block</p>
