Question to explore	Which creature has the sharpest teeth?
Historical Coverage	Dinosaurs
	Exploring the life and work of Mary Anning
NC Coverage	The lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements
Chronology sequencing events/ objects in time; using chronological vocabulary	Locate her lifetime on class/ school timeline. Create a pictorial timeline of her life
Characteristic features of period/ person/ events studied	Explore how attitudes to gender/ class at the time, restricted recognition of her achievements.
Cause/ consequence - why people did things/ causes and results of events and changes	Explore Mary's motivation, and the consequences of her discoveries- helped change understanding of how life evolved.
Significance	Create a museum display about Mary's work, and how she is recognized today and in the past.
Interpretation –explore ways we find out about the past and how it is represented	Explore representations/ interpretations: books/ video/ websites/ Lyme Regis museum, Jurassic coast info boards etc.
Historical enquiry –asking /answering questions; using sources to find answers and show understanding	Dino day for artefacts, and other sources plus books postcards, etc
Key Historical Vocabulary - discuss and remember and embed	Evolution - The way that living things change over time. Inheritance - Offspring receiving certain traits, behaviour or characteristics from their mum and dad Fossil - The remains or traces of plants and animals that lived long ago. Natural Selection - Animals best suited to their habitat survive. Adaptation - Changes to animals that help them to survive in their habitat. Charles Darwin - Created the Theory of Evolution. Mary Anning - A famous fossil hunter.
