Question to explore	What happens at sea
DT Coverage	Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria

Design	Children to design a ship/boat that is both purposeful and functional. They will need to draw template and make up a mock up ship that will float. They will need to explore floating and sinking and design a boat using a suitable material.
