(daily or ideally 5 times a week)

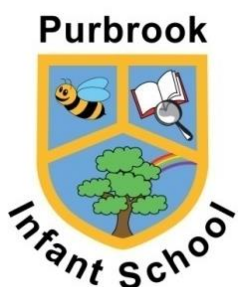
### Practise counting
