English

We will be looking at the Year 2 words (found in the front of your child's reading record), the suffixes -er and -est (to compare e.g. bigger, smaller, tallest, widest) and homophones (words which sound the same but look different e.g. blue, blew, bear, bare, be, bee).

Maths

- Measuring Weight and length
- We measure in cm and m, grams and kilograms.
- Simply comparing items linked to length or weight will help your child understand the context behind the complex language we use. (e.g. I am taller than you, but Daddy is the tallest)

Reading

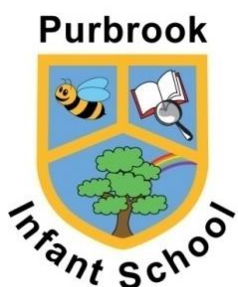
(daily or ideally 5 times a week)
