Dear Parents/Carers

Your child has been given a report of progress today. This report gives you detailed information about your child's progress for the academic year 2021/2022. Included in the envelope is information relating to your child's end of Key Stage One Assessments. There is also information relating to your child's Phonics Screening Assessment. We urge you not to worry if this report states that your child is not yet on track or has not yet met their target. These targets are set by the government and were set before we even knew what a pandemic was and this year nationally, results are lower and rightly so. What you need to take away from these reports is how hard the children have worked and how much they have already overcome in their young lives. These results do not show how resilient they are when met with a new challenge, how they developed their perseverance when school was not a familiar place after so much disrupted schooling. It does not show how kind and caring they are, how they have had to learn to play and share with other children after months of being told getting close to people is dangerous. It doesn't show how they learned to play a new musical instrument or developed a creative flair for painting or building, nor does it show how fast they can run, how they can climb trees and build dens and ride bikes! Overall attainment is one small element of your child's experiences of school, it is everything else that matters and I know I am incredibly proud of each and every child in this school for their achievements and successes. This year the government have asked all schools to share with parents comparative data. As the last National data available is 2019 our 2022 data is shown in comparison. Normally our school is above the National average, however, this year we are below the 2019 National average. The 2019 data is pre-pandemic and our children have missed two full years of their early education so it is not surprising that our results are not as high as our pre-pandemic results. We are proud of their achievements as I am sure you are too.

As always, the teachers have spent considerable time, and effort, to ensure that your child's report is a true reflection of this year's achievements and we would really appreciate a few moments of your time to add your comments. Please click on the [Google Form Link](#).
