Starting School in September 2023

If your child is 4 or will turn before 1 September 2023, they can start school in September. If you have not already applied for a place, you need to do so by tomorrow, Sunday 15 January. Hampshire residents should apply via the online portal: www.hants.gov.uk/admissions. Other residents should apply to their own Council, for example Portsmouth City Council or West Sussex Council.

Opportunity to try a School Lunch – Thursday 19 January
