Today in assembly the children were introduced to National Storytelling Week.

National Storytelling Week takes place every year and is a celebration of the power of sharing stories. Stories teach us about the world, they allow us to step into someone else's shoes and feel empathy, they help us to relax and escape and they can help develop essential literacy skills.

At school we use many tools and a range of media to help us tell stories. These include:

- Oral retelling and recording on a story tin or using Seesaw
- Helicopter stories
- Role play
- Small world toys
- Make it up Monday using story stones and story sacks
- Story boarding grids
- Plus, many more!



To help raise the importance of reading, knowing stories and creating our own, we are setting the challenge to all the children to create their own story or retell their favourite story in their own words. They can choose any way they want to share this back with us (some resources can be found alongside this letter); these can be used to help if needed.
