### Red, White and Blue Day:

The children are invited to come to school wearing red, white and blue. We will be outside in the afternoon so request that the children are dressed appropriately, a jumper/cardigan/light coat if the weather is cool or covered up shoulders if the weather is hot. Please apply any sun cream as you normally would. Currently the weather forecast for next Friday is good so fingers crossed!

Children can bring their crown to wear and we will have a parade to see all of the great designs. We will pick a winner from each year group; we cannot wait to see you showcasing your crowns!

### Coronation Lunch

The school's catering company, HC3S are providing the children with a Coronation themed picnic lunch. All children are welcome to have this Royal/British themed lunch, but if you would prefer, you can provide your child with a packed lunch from home.
