Dear Parents/Carers

Your child has been given a report of progress today. This report gives you detailed information about your child's progress for the academic year 2022/2023. Included in the envelope there is also information relating to your child's end of Key Stage One Assessments. The report also shows the Phonics screening test results. All children were tested last June when they were in Year 1 and the results were notified to parents last year. This will show on your report as Phonics Screening Mark Check.

If your child did not reach the required standard in the Phonics Screening Assessment last year they were retested recently and a copy of their result has been printed separately and is included with your child's report.

We urge you not to worry if this report states that your child is not yet on track or has not yet met their target. These targets are set by the government. What you need to take away from these reports is how hard the children have worked and how much they have already learnt in their young lives. It does not show how kind and caring they are. It doesn't show how they learned to play a new musical instrument or developed a creative flair for painting or building, nor does it show how fast they can run, how they can climb trees and build dens and ride bikes! Overall attainment is one small element of your child's experiences of school, it is everything else that matters and I know I am incredibly proud of each and every child in this school for their achievements and successes.

As always, the teachers have spent considerable time, and effort, to ensure that your child's report is a true reflection of this year's achievements and we would really appreciate a few moments of your time to add your comments. Please click on the Google Form Link.

In addition, you will have a report of attendance and punctuality (including authorised and unauthorised attendances). It should be noted that the school day is recorded as two sessions (morning and afternoon). The attendance reported is from 01 September 2022 until 01 July 2023.
