Year 1 Space Day Wednesday 20 September 2023

We are really excited to be arranging a 'Space Experience' for the Year 1 children on Wednesday 20 September 2023. It will be a morning session that will immerse the children in learning about the moon and the moon landings, building on aspects that they are keen to find out more about:

- What do we find in space?
- How do we get to space?

The children will have the opportunity to visit a mobile planetarium which will enable us to experience the sights and sounds of space in a really exciting way. We are really keen to provide the children with experiences that enhance their learning such as the planetarium however, we are reliant on voluntary contributions from parents to cover the costs as the school budget does not enable us to offer these. A voluntary contribution of £5.40 will cover the costs of our space day.
