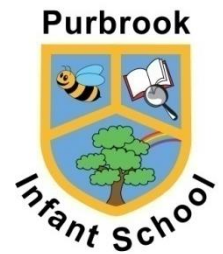

Dear Parents/Carers of Children in Year 1

**WHOLE SCHOOL TRIP TO MARWELL ZOO: YOUR CHILD WILL BE VISITING ON WEDNESDAY 20 MARCH**

The overarching theme this term for all year groups is 'Into The Wild' with each year group taking a different element of this with a key question to ask. Year 1 are wondering 'which creatures have the sharpest teeth? As part of our work and learning around this theme, we have planned a trip to Marwell Zoo.

A contribution of £11.50 will cover the cost of the coach travel and the entrance to Marwell Zoo. As the cost of trips have risen substantially over the last few years the PTFA are subsidising a large amount of the cost for us to make this possible. Please note the coaches are fitted with seat-belts. This trip will not only be an important part of our follow up work in class but is a whole school enrichment trip.

We are very excited to share that Year 1 will be visiting the zoo and spending time with the Robins and Wagtails in Year R, taking on a responsibility and caring role. We very much hope that you will be able to support your child and the school in this activity. We ask that you return the reply slip and monies in an envelope marked with your child's name and class.

During the day, each class will have the opportunity to explore the zoo and the large range of animals and varied enclosures. We will follow the trail and we will spend time playing together at the parks and having a picnic lunch in the glorious gardens and grounds.

To enhance our time spent at the Zoo we would ask that you get your child to school early on this day. **The Year 1 doors will be open from 8.30am**, this will allow us to get the children all toileted and on the coach **ready to leave at 9.00 am**. Please arrive before this time.

The school can provide your child with a FREE packed lunch at your request. This will consist of a cheese roll, mini sausage roll, shortbread biscuit and an apple. We ask that you provide your child with an extra bottled drink with a lid so we can refill if needed as the children will be walking quite a long way during the day. **All children** must come to school with a back pack as they will all be expected to carry their own lunch and drink. If you provide all items that can be thrown away, this will help lighten your child's load after lunch. (Avoid any Tupperware in case it is accidently thrown away)!!!!

If you would like us to order a packed lunch for your child, then please tick the appropriate box when completing the consent form and also state this on the **front of your envelope**. If you would prefer, you may provide your child with a packed lunch and drink.

The children will be walking for a considerable part of the day and we recommend they wear sensible walking shoes and their school jumper. However, they are able to wear suitable non-school uniform below their jumper e.g. jeans/leggings or tracksuit/jogging bottoms. Please make sure that they are dressed appropriately whatever the weather e.g. **think coat, hat and scarf** if it is cold or a waterproof coat if it is raining.

The children should not bring any money or cameras. If your child suffers from travel sickness please give him/her a tablet (if you usually do this) at the beginning of the day. Any tablet that is required to be taken for the return trip should be given to your child's class teacher in the original packaging together with a letter of authorisation. Please indicate in the letter the time at which the tablet should be given.

If you wish your child to go on the visit, please sign the slip below and return it with your payment by **Monday 11 March**. You will shortly receive a text message providing you with information as to how to pay for this trip online. Cheques should be made payable to Hampshire County Council. If you wish to pay by cash, then please enclose the correct money where possible. If you do require change then please be advised that this may not be issued on the day payment is made. All consent forms must be returned in order for your child to take part in this visit, unless you pay online where consent is automatically given. Please be aware that if a significant number of places are not paid for we will be unable to offer this trip or others like it in the future. Please indicate on the return slip if you are able to help.

We are all looking forward to a very exciting and enjoyable day.
