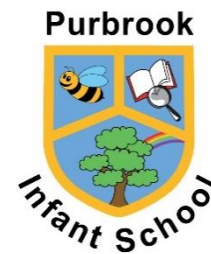

**YEAR 2 EDUCATIONAL VISITOR – TUESDAY 30 APRIL**

As part of this half term’s work, we have invited a travelling bug expert in to visit the children. Bugfest Mobile Bugs will be visiting on the morning of Tuesday 30 April, and will bring a variety of minibeasts; such as tarantulas, millipedes, scorpions, hissing cockroaches and many, many more for the children to explore and learn from in a safely controlled manner.

The children will have the opportunity to meet and interact with the minibeasts with their class, and ask questions about what type of minibeast they are, how they are categorised, their lifecycles and their habitats, as this forms part of this term’s science topic. They will be able to handle some of the minibeasts if they feel happy to. We appreciate to some, this may sound terrifying, but we promise this will allow the children to explore real life learning in the classroom with minibeasts they wouldn’t normally come across, bringing awe and wonder to their learning journey, no one will be asked to hold something if they do not feel comfortable doing so.
