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

Please can you ensure that your child arrives in school by 8.50am so that we are able to discuss with them the importance of listening to instructions; staying with their adult, and also have time to remind them of our expectations regarding behaviour.

We will need to keep our lunches with us so could you send your child to a school with a **rucksack**.

They will also need sensible shoes, these **do not** need to be school shoes, however **full school uniform and a coat** will be required, and it is likely to be very cold around the docks and on the boat so please wrap up warm. Children should not bring any money or cameras. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give him/her a tablet (if you usually do this) at the beginning of the day. Any tablet that is required to be taken for the return trip should be given to your child's class teacher in the original packaging together with a letter of authorisation. Please indicate in the letter the time at which the tablet should be given.

Lunch orders for the trip: Please note that orders for lunch must be placed by 9.00am on Wednesday 28 January so catering staff can make these first thing in the morning. **They will not be checking school grid on the day.**

Driving and Parking at School Collection Times – Important Reminder

The school office has received a complaint from a local resident regarding driving and parking on Shaftesbury Avenue at school drop off and collection times. We have been asked to remind parents and carers to park and drive with consideration for local residents, pedestrians and other road users.

The resident has highlighted that the road is already difficult and hazardous to navigate, and that conditions worsen significantly at drop off/pick-up times, particularly around Westbrook Grove and Queens Grove. Of particular concern are reports of vehicles mounting pavements, which is unacceptable, dangerous, and illegal.

We ask all parents and carers to show consideration for those who live in the local area and to drive and park responsibly at all times. By doing so, we can help ensure the safety of our neighbours, our families, and all road users.

This is available for parents to view and order online. Please go to <https://app.schoolgrid.co.uk/> where you can view and order a lunch for your child.

Ordering in Advance: You can order in advance for the whole week (possibly longer). If you do this but then your child is not in school before 9.15am because you are late or are taking them to an appointment but you haven't informed us of this, **their lunch request will be cancelled** and you will need to provide them with a packed lunch. Whilst lunches are free to parents, the school has to pay for these.

If your child has an appointment and will be in late but requires a lunch that day, please let us know by leaving the school a voicemail. We have set up a designated telephone option – option 4. You can pre-order a lunch or leave us a message (before 9.15am). We just need you to let us know that your child will be in later that day. Please do not leave a message on the normal absence line as staff may not get to your message in time and your child's lunch will be cancelled.
