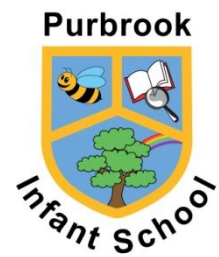

Off Limits – Stony Area Outside Junior School Entrance

We have been asked by Purbrook Junior School, to remind our families that children should not play in the stoned area outside their reception and office entrance. This area is causing disruption to the school office due to noise, and there are also hygiene concerns as it is known to be used by local wildlife. Children may come into contact with stones and surfaces that could harbour bacteria and other contaminants.

We would be grateful for your support in reminding your child to walk sensibly through this area and to avoid playing in this area when arriving at or leaving school.

Ordering in Advance: You can order in advance for the whole week (possibly longer). If you do this but then your child is not in school before 9.15am because you are late or are taking them to an appointment but you haven't informed us of this, **their lunch request will be cancelled** and you will need to provide them with a packed lunch. Whilst lunches are free to parents, the school has to pay for these.

If your child has an appointment and will be in late but requires a lunch that day, please let us know by leaving the school a voicemail. We have set up a designated telephone option – option 4. You can pre-order a lunch or leave us a message (before 9.15am). We just need you to let us know that your child will be in later that day. Please do not leave a message on the normal absence line as staff may not get to your message in time and your child's lunch will be cancelled.
